We would love it if you could share your Young Ambassador year with us through social media, so here are a few promises from us:

- By tweeting us, tagging us in your photos or using #YAscotland we will assume you are happy for us to retweet, repost or share them don't send us anything you wouldn't want us to share further
- We won't pass your photos or information on to anyone else
- We will remove anything you are not comfortable with if you let us know – you can do this confidentially by direct messaging the account or emailing youngambassadors@sportscotland.org.uk.

Most of all, we want you to make sure your information is safe and secure. So here are some tips for staying safe online:

- Don't post pictures or comments that you wouldn't be happy for the whole world to see - remember they are public as soon as you hit send.
- Think before you post who else will see it, and are you going to offend anyone with your message?
- If the image/video you're posting features other people, make sure you have their permission before sharing.
- Make sure your social media activity complies with the community standards, guidelines or rules of that platform:
  - o <u>Twitter rules and policies</u>
  - o <u>Instagram community guidelines</u>
  - o Facebook community standards
  - o Snapchat community quidelines
